HINARI UPDATES

We are excited to announce that Sao Tome & Principe have been officially invited to register with HINARI and receive access to more than 3,300 of their biomedical and related social science journals. Eligible categories of institutions that can now benefit from such access include universities, research institutes, professional schools (medicine, nursing, pharmacy, public health, dentistry), teaching hospitals, government offices and national medical libraries.

All staff members and students are entitled to access to the journals.

In regard to new publications, HINARI just supplemented its online library with the Brazilian Journal of Nursing. It can be easily accessed in the alphabetical listing of the HINARI journals.

In addition the Mozambique Paediatric Day Hospital, part of the Maputo Central Hospital was registered with HINARI on May 13, 2006.
